

COVID-19 UPDATE FOR IRON GATE RESIDENTS

The Town of Iron Gate Town Council has met and discussed the changing events and CDC and VDH recommendations for the coronavirus. At this time, the following has been decided:

There will be no organized events, including any special/scheduled events for the Town Playground and the River Park. Once they open on April 1, 2020 anyone who wishes to be at either facility, it will be at their own risk.

The trash pickup will take place approximately 2 hours LATER than normal, due to other circumstances. Please remember that if you need to speak to the Town crew during this time, to practice social distancing.

The Town Clerk's office will be open, but only to essential personnel and not to the general public. We ask that people please use the drop box out front of Town Hall for any payments or correspondence. If your utility bill or taxes need to be paid by debit or credit card, we will accept those payments by phone. Since the card processing system is fee based, we will waive the higher keyed debit card fee and only charge the lower fee for in-person payments. Anyone who wishes to have a receipt can have one mailed or one can be placed in your door. The office hours will remain the same for all Town Offices at this time.

There will be no water cutoffs at this time but any late fees and penalties will continue to incur.

We ask that if you are sick to please stay home and to continue practicing hand washing/sanitizing as necessary. At this time you may call 1-877-ASK-VDH3 for any information on how you can protect yourself from COVID-19.
